# Welcome Class of 2021

The courses listed on the 9th Grade Course Selection Sheet are the courses you can take.

Our Course Description Book lists core classes first, followed by electives. Be sure to read the descriptions of classes so that you select courses carefully.

When reading the course descriptions: 1) look at the grades that the course is open to, 2) look at the fees per class, *especially AP fees due in the spring*, 3) see if the course is one or two semesters, 4) look if there is a prerequisite (for example, you must have taken Beginning Guitar before Guitar 2) and 5) see if an application or audition required. Classes that require an audition will be placed on your request list if you have been accepted into the class, i.e. Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band, some choir classes, Student Government and Yearbook.

### Choosing the correct **Core classes** for your freshman:

- You will select an English class: English 9 or Honors English 9
- You will select a Social Studies class: World Geo/History or AP Human Geo
- You will select a Science class: Biology or Honors Biology
- Your current Math teacher should recommend your math class. We do not have a placement test.

### Choosing **Electives** for your freshman:

- Health & 2 semesters of Study Hall are requirements for all freshman and will automatically be placed on your requests.
- We highly recommend that your student take Core PE in 9th grade.
- World Language is considered an elective. (FYI most colleges/universities want 3
  consecutive years of a foreign language.) We offer Spanish and Chinese; classes are two
  semesters (all year) long.
  - If you have successfully passed Spanish 1 or Mandarin Chinese 1 with a C grade or above in middle school, we recommend you start with Spanish 2 or Chinese 2 in high school.
- There are classes at CDC and the Innovation Center, (located in Longmont, bussing is provided from EHS) that are open to freshman. Check the Erie Counseling website for links to these opportunities: <a href="https://www.eriehighcounseling.com">www.eriehighcounseling.com</a>

Your core classes, plus Health and Study Hall, will count for 11 of 9th graders 16 classes. Students will be placed into the core classes that you request but you may not get all of your requested electives - this is why Alternates are important! Your Alternates are your **second** choices for electives. Counselors use these often to finalize schedules. Do not choose CDC classes as an Alternate because CDC classes are filled several months before the semester begins.

You must pick enough classes to total 16 (all-year classes count as 2), for example:

- (2) English 9
- (2) World History
- (2) Honors Geometry
- (2) Honors Biology
- (2) Study Hall
- (1) Health
- (2) Spanish
- (1) Core PE
- (1) Crafts
- (1) Beginning Photography
- 16 total classes

Schedules will not be released until August. There are LIMITED schedule changes. Please choose your classes wisely.
