Location and Community

Erie, Colorado is a town of over 20,000 located 20 miles north of Denver, 15 miles east of Boulder. Erie High School is in the St. Vrain Valley School District and is accredited by the Colorado Department of Education. EHS is a member of the Colorado Council of High School/College Relations.

Enrollment

In 2016-2017 Erie High's enrollment is 1048 students.

School Year

Erie High's school year is on a two semester system (174 instructional days). Erie High operates on an alternating 85 minute block schedule. Each class meets every other day. There is also one 20 minute Sustained Silent Reading time daily.

Grades and Ranking

AP classes are weighted on a 5 point scale. Honor classes are weighted on a 4.5 scale. GPA is calculated using only semester grades. Class rankings are based on cumulative GPA.

Curriculum & Specialty Programming

Over 160 classes are offered each semester at Erie High:

Honors Classes: Algebra 2, Biology, Chemistry, English 9, English 10, Geometry, Pre-Calculus with Trigonometry, World History

Front Range Community College Classes: English Composition, General Psychology, Intro to Criminal Justice, Intro to Political Science and Policing Systems.
