SVVS After School eCredit



The St. Vrain eCredit Recovery program provides students the opportunity to recover essential credits from failed courses allowing them to get back on track to graduate with their class. This hybrid program offers the best of online learning and combines it with face-to-face instruction and support from core content teachers.

Requirements of SVVS After School eCredit Program:

- 1. **Mandatory Attendance:** A strict in-person daily attendance policy is enforced. If a student misses 2 classes of scheduled e-Credit, they are at risk of being dropped from the program. We have limited spots available for students to utilize, and every year, we have students that sit on a waiting list to take advantage of this amazing opportunity.
- 2. Class Progress. Students can work at their own pace and have the opportunity to exit the program as soon as they have finished a course.

Cost: \$150/0.5 credits \$75/0.5 credits if you qualify for free/reduced lunch (Only sign up for one course. If time allows, students can register for a 2nd course and receive a discount. Discount applied for 2nd course ONLY and ONLY after the first course has been completed)

English -- English 9A/9B, English 10A/10B, English 11A/11B, English 12A/12B Social Studies -- World Studies A/B, US History A/B, US Government A/B, Personal Financial Literacy

Science -- Biology A/B, Chemistry A/B, Physics A/B (Only offered at FHS and LHS campuses)

Math -- Algebra 1A/1B, Geometry A/B, Algebra 2A/2B, Intermediate Algebra A/B (No math available at Erie)

Others -- Health

Summer eCredit classes run from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm on each day (Monday through Friday) starting Monday, June 6, 2022 and ending Friday, June 24, 2022
