



Open Enrollment dates for the 2021-2022 school year

- **Tuesday, December 1, 2020 - Tuesday, December 15, 2020:** Open Enrollment Window to submit your open enrollment applications online. Check back here for time that window goes live on 12/1.
- **Monday, January 18, 2021** - Deadline to receive letter from school regarding an offer of acceptance, waitlist or denial status.
- **Monday, February 1, 2021** - Deadline for families to accept or reject your offered open enrollment spot at a school via the family dashboard

Open Enrollment FAQ

What is Open Enrollment (OE)?

OE is an opportunity for a student to attend a school of choice which is outside of their attendance area. In-district students applying to a school outside of their attendance area, as well as students who do not live within district boundaries but want to attend a school in St. Vrain, need to complete the online application form.

All schools allow open enrollments, however some schools may not have space available for open enrollment. Each year the Board of Education reviews school populations, enrollment projections, building capacities and staff sizes and determines what schools can permit open enrollment.

Who should Open Enroll?

- Students who live within the boundaries of St. Vrain, and wish to attend a school outside of their neighborhood school. ([Check your address here](#))
- Students who live outside the boundaries of St. Vrain, and wish to attend a school within the district.
- Current 8th grade students who want to enroll for their 9th grade year at EHS, that is not their neighborhood school
 - Students who are currently attending their school of choice on open enrollment do NOT need to reapply each year in order to remain at the same school - continuous enrollment at EHS is required.

I live in your attendance area but do not attend EMS or SH. How do I enroll my student?

Please contact Leticia Tapia, our Registrar, for details on enrolling your student at EHS. If you're coming from within SVVSD (i.e. ARPS, Flagstaff Academy or any SVVSD charter schools) our Registrar will need to confirm your home address and contact information in order to enroll you. If your student is attending a school outside of SVVSD, you'll need to complete [online registration](#) (for the 2021-2022 school year) and turn in all required documentation before enrollment is complete. Mrs. Tapia's contact information is below.

I currently have an open enrolled student attending EHS; will his/her sibling be accepted?

Open enrollment will be approved for a younger sibling if the older sibling will be enrolled at the school for at least one more year. Parents DO still need to submit an OE online application for their younger child, even if an older sibling is already attending.

Can I open enroll at other St. Vrain high schools?

Yes, but you'll need to submit an application for each school. Once your OE has been accepted at one school, we do ask that you promptly let the other schools know of your acceptance so your application can be pulled off their list or your spot can be given to another student.
