


SCHOOLOGY COURSE FOR 9-12TH TEACHERS


The District Technolgy folks have created a Schoology course for all high school educators called "SVVSD High School Grades 9-12 Teachers".

LAPTOP HEALTH

DTS is reporting that the glass screens on many teacher laptops are breaking. 

Note that using rubrics to grade routine tasks really helps to streamline things. Once you grade with the rubric, you can use the Schoology/IC Grade Passback to import the rubric grade right into Infinite Campus.

YOUTUBE

If you, or your students, are unable to get YouTube videos to play, remember you can go to the website: override.svvsd.org. Once you go to this site, you will need to sign in with your svvsd credentials. Make sure to leave the page open and then go into YouTube.

By logging in, you will be granted 10 hours of use. You will need to do this everyday you need to access YouTube.

If you are using a laptop, Make sure that you restart everyday and you will not have to use the override procedure. Restarting your laptop daily is a good habit to get into as it helps with many daily issues that arrise.

GALE DATABASES

GALE databases are available to all SVVSD students and staff. The information that can be accessed is very powerful.
